THE RELIANCE CUP TRIAL
Sunday 3rd June 2018

A classic trial for machines of pre-65 British manufacture using as many farm tracks and B roads as possible.

- CLASSES: 1 Telefork Rigid 2 Pre-Unit Clubman 3 Vintage Two Stroke 4 Clubman
5 Pre-Unit Expert 6 Unit Expert 7 Two Stroke Expert 8 Specials

ELIGIBILITY: Frames, motors, gearboxes, carburettors, hubs and forks shall be of British manufacture, unless otherwise fitted by the manufacturer and have been on general sale to the public before 31 December 1964 for all pre-unit classes...

RIDERS: It is the rider's responsibility to ensure that your bike, helmet and clothing conform to the Road Traffic Act.

AWARDS: All finishers will receive points towards the Northern British Bike Championship. Every rider who completes all rounds of the Championship will also receive an award at the completion of the series.

ENTRIES: The event is open to solo machines of British manufacture. Entries will be accepted up to 29th May 2018. Entry fee £20 (which includes Personal Accident and off-road insurance).

START: 10.30 am at Booth Farm, High Peak, Buxton, SK17 0RP (Map ref 058681), sign posted from the minor road junction on A53. 1 mile south of junction with A54. Approx 2 1/2 miles south of Buxton.

COURSE: One lap of approx 30 miles, with approx 30 sections comprising of 2 routes to be ridden by all competitors. Marking will be 0, 1, 2, 3, 5. Failure is deemed to have occurred when the front wheel ceases forward motion.
