All machines must have the main frame, engine, gearbox & front forks of British manufacture (or appearance). Classes 1 to 4, will ride the Eased / Clubman Route.

It is the responsibility of the rider to ensure that their machine is fully insured, road legal and in safe working order. Legal safety helmets must always be worn when riding.
